RESOLUTION NO. 21 - 58

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL CENTRO CONDITIONALLY RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 20-52 AND RE-ESTABLISHING RATES FOR THE INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT SERVICES INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE COLLECTION, TRANSPORTATION, RECYCLING, PROCESSING AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE

WHEREAS, Chapter 12 of the Code of the City of El Centro, California ("the City") provides that the monthly rates for the collection of solid waste, green waste and recyclables ("integrated waste management services") shall be adopted by resolution of the City Council of the City of El Centro, California ("the City Council"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved an Integrated Waste Management Services Agreement ("the Agreement") with CR&R Incorporated ("CR&R"), an active California corporation, on April 18, 2007, which Agreement has been amended, most recently in 2013 to provide for annual cost of living increases pursuant to a formula verified by an independent consultant; and

WHEREAS, CR&R may request rates to be adjusted annually under section 6.3.1 of the Agreement by following the procedures of Section 6.4 "Method of Adjustments" of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, per the Agreement, adjustment to the rates is subject to approval by City Council at a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, City Council discretion is limited by the Agreement to determine, based on substantial evidence, whether the requested rate adjustment meets the requirements of Section 6.4 "Method of Adjustments"; and

WHEREAS, per Amendment No.3 of the Agreement, effective July 5, 2011, any adjustment may not increase or decrease by more than four (4%) annually and there shall not be any carryforwards; and

WHEREAS, rates were last set in 2020 pursuant to Resolution No. 20-52; and

WHEREAS, CR&R has requested that the City approve a 1.2% annual increase to the solid waste disposal service charges for residential and commercial cart and bin services pursuant to Section 6 of the Agreement, effective July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, CR&R has requested that the City approve a 1.7% annual increase to the solid waste disposal service charges for roll-off box services pursuant to Section 6 of the Agreement, effective July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, such rates have been reviewed independently by HF&H Consultants, LLC based upon the factors and percentage set out in Section 6.4 of the Agreement, including a minor decrease to the percent change in rates as requested by CR&R; and

WHEREAS, this change results in a 0.1% decrease to the adjustment requested for Roll-Off Box Service and a 0.2% decrease to the requested adjustment for Cart and Bin Service when compared to CR&R's initial request and such rates as determined by HF&H and set out in Exhibits 1 and 2 are recommended; and

WHEREAS, based upon the report of that consultant, the City Council finds that said rates meet the requirements for increase and further are reasonably related to the costs of providing and maintaining integrated waste management services and are within the rates approved by the Council after notice and hearing; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2021, the City Council conducted a duly noticed public hearing on the proposed annual rate increase for the integrated waste management services including but not limited to collection, transportation, recycling, processing and disposal of solid waste within the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to adjust said rates and charges as set forth herein below.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL CENTRO, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the foregoing is true, correct and adopted.
- 2. That Resolution No. 20-52 hereby is conditionally rescinded. Should a court of competent jurisdiction declare this resolution to be legally invalid or otherwise legally deficient for any reason, then the provisions of Resolution No. 20-52 as applicable to said integrated waste management services rates shall not be deemed

to have been repealed and shall remain in full force and effect as to said integrated solid waste management services.

3. That the fees and charges for the collection, transportation, recycling, processing and disposal of solid waste shall be as set forth in the following exhibits which are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Exhibit 1 – Solid Waste Collection Rate Schedule, July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 Rates.

Exhibit 2 – Calculation of July 1, 2021 Rate Adjustment, Single Family & Commercial Rate Calculation/Roll-Off Rate Calculation.

4. That the effective date of the new rate schedule will be July 1, 2021.
